Art Club Executive Board Application 2010-2011

Art Club Exec Board positions are open to Bryn Mawr students, whether or not they are current members of Art Club. Our main focus is encouraging art on Bryn Mawr's campus and within the community. We run workshops, maintain an open and stocked studio, bring artists to campus, and run weekly Community Art Night.

The Art Club Exec Board is run by consensus, which is to say that all agreements are done by a process of discussion rather than by voting. This means that responsibilities are shared and everyone understands what other people are doing, so they can step-up if another member is sick or needs help.

Exec Board Positions:

Because Art Club is an intensely collaborative organization, all positions will involve helping to run classes, organize events, and maintaining the studio.

Co-President—runs Art Club. Works on all aspects Art Club. Maintains listserv.

Vice President—helps co-presidents with maintaining the studio and organizing events. Runs Community Art Night.

Treasurer—writes budget, keeps spreadsheet of expenses and hands in receipts for student reimbursement. Monitors the Art Club comptroller account.

Stenographer – takes minutes at meeting, edits minutes, sends them to Exec Board members and posts them on the gmail account.

Publicist—makes posters and sends emails for Art Club events. Educates the community about Art Club, Art Club's resources, and how to get involved. For 2010-2011 the Publicist will also take on Webmistress duties.

Webmistress/webmaster – updates the Art Club blog with photos, notices about events, and summaries of meeting minutes.

Community Outreach Coordinator – helps coordinate collaboration with other groups on campus and with the wider community.

Ideally each position would be held for the entire year but if need be the Exec Board can seek out a replacement between semesters. Several of the positions are not going to be open for 2010-2011: Vice-President, Publicist, and Community Outreach Coordinator.
